

# STYLE SHEET

## 1. TITLE

Title, subtitle, photo, romance

## 2. PATTERN INFORMATION

- ◇ Sizes XS (S, M, L, XL, XXL) with measurements to fit in both inches and cm
- ◇ Sizes Small, Medium, and Large for 3 sizes
- ◇ Ease and fitting suggestions
- ◇ Reference to schematic on last page

## MATERIALS

### YARN

- ◇ yds/m for each size, add 10%, multiply yds by .914 for meters
- ◇ Generic description; fingering, sport, dk, or worsted weight yarn that give you the gauge...
- ◇ Fiber type and fabric properties (memory, drape, stretch, stitch definition, fuzz, etc.)
- ◇ Yarn label information for yarn used

### NEEDLES

- ◇ Size and length in inches and cm and where that needle is used.
- ◇ US size/mm size *or size needed to obtain gauge*, (length in inches/cm) circular needle, and double-pointed needles or magic loop needle for sleeves.
- ◇ US size/mm size 2 sizes/.5 mm smaller than gauge needle for garter st edges.

### OTHERS

- ◇ Buttons
- ◇ Stitch markers
- ◇ Waste yarn or stitch holders
- ◇ Crochet hook

## NOTES

- ◇ An overview of the construction
- ◇ Reference to special techniques and tutorials

## GAUGE

- ◇ Gauge over 4 inches/10 cm in main stitch patterns with needle size and *after blocking*.

## ABBREVIATIONS

- ◇ Abbreviations in bracketed text box taken from abbreviations list.

## 3. PATTERN

- ◇ With MC and larger needles, using the Tubular Cast-On...
- ◇ With smaller needles and waste yarn, using the Provisional Cast-On...
- ◇ Using the Crochet Chain Cast-On, cast on 5,000 sts.
- ◇ *Sizes S, M, and L only*
- ◇ *All sizes*
- ◇ *CHANGE TO CC*
- ◇ **Row 1 (WS):**
- ◇ **Dec Row (RS):** K2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. 4 sts dec'd.
- ◇ **Next Row (WS) and all foll WS rows:**
- ◇ Knit and purl are spelled out when they are not followed by a number.

### REPEATS

- ◇ Rep Rows 1 and 2 five (five, five, six, six, six) more times.
- ◇ Rep the last 2 rows five more times.
- ◇ Work 21 rows even in patt as set ending with a WS row. Piece measures 3 inches/7.5 cm.
- ◇ Rep Dec Row every 4th row five (five, five, six, six, six) more times. 72 (76, 80, 84, 88, 92) sts.
- ◇ Work 12 (14, 16, 18, 20, 22) sts in rib patt, pm, k5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10).
- ◇ Stitch counts after each inc/dec section.
- ◇ \*K2, p2; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, k2.
- ◇ K3, \*[k2tog] three times, [k1, yo] six times, [k2tog] three times; repeat from \* twice more, k3.

- ◇ Use first, second, third, fourth, etc. for ordinal numbers
- ◇ Once, twice, three more times.

## 4. FINISHING

- ◇ **Bind Off:** K2, pass first st over second, \*k1, pass first st over second; repeat from \* to end.
- ◇ Finishing- sew on buttons, weave in ends.
- ◇ Blocking
- ◇ Schematic and measurements in inches and cm

### OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- ◇ Name of pattern and page number in the header on every page except the first
- ◇ Copyright and contact information in the footer on every page
- ◇ Row counts where applicable and measurements in inches and cm.
- ◇ All measurements in inches and cm rounded to the nearest ¼ inch and .5 cm. No space before/after virgule.
- ◇ Place the st patt instructions, charts, and chart key in the pattern when the st is first used, or if there is not enough space, on a separate page.
- ◇ Stitch patterns in rows and rnds where applicable
- ◇ Charts and written instructions adjacent whenever possible

beg: begin; beginning  
 2/2 LC: 2 over 2 left cable  
 2/2 RC: 2 over 2 right cable  
 CC: contrast color  
 cm: centimeters  
 cn: cable needle  
 cont: continue

 dec(s): decrease(s), decreasing  
 dpn(s): double-pointed needles  
 ds: double stitch (German Short Rows); slip stitch as if

to purl with yarn in front, pull yarn up and to back of work

fol: following

inc'd: increased

inc(s): increase(s); increasing

k: knit

k1b: knit 1 in the row below

k1 tbl: knit 1 through back loop

k2tog: right leaning dec; knit 2 together

kfb: knit 1 front and back

knitwise: as if to knit

m: marker

M1L: make 1 left; with left needle, lift the yarn between the needles from the front, knit into the back of this loop

M1L (M1Lp): make 1 left (make 1 left purl); with left needle, lift the yarn between the needles from the front, knit (purl) into the back of this loop

M1R: make 1 right; with left needle, lift the yarn between the needles from the back, knit into the front of this loop

M1R (M1Rp): make 1 right (make 1 right purl); with left needle, lift the yarn between the needles from the back, knit (purl) into the front of this loop

MC: main color

mm: millimeters

oz: ounces

p: purl

p1b: purl 1 in the row below

p2tog: right leaning dec; purl 2 together

p1 tbl: purl 1 through back loop

patt: pattern

pfb: purl 1 front and back

pm: place marker

[prov cast-on: provisional cast-on](#)

pssso: pass slipped stitch over

puk: pick up and knit

purlwise: as if to purl

rev: reverse

rm: remove marker

RS: right side

sl1: slip 1

sl1-k2tog-pssso: double decrease; slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over

sl2-k1-p2sso: centered double decrease; slip 2 stitches as if to knit 2 together, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches over

sm: slip marker

ssk: left leaning dec; slip next 2 stitches one at a time as if to knit, return to left needle and knit 2 together through back loops

ssp: left leaning decrease; slip next 2 stitches one at a time as if to knit, return stitches to left needle and purl 2 together through back loops

sssk: left leaning double decrease; slip next 3 sts one at a time as if to knit, return stitches to left needle and knit 3 together through back loops

St st: stockinette st

st(s): stitch; stitches

tbl: through back loop(s)

tog: together

WS: wrong side

wyb: with yarn in back

wyf: with yarn in front

yb: yarn back; bring the yarn to the back between the needles

yd(s): yard(s)

yf: yarn forward; bring the yarn to the front between the needles

yo: yarn over

yo2: double yarn over; yarn over needle twice
